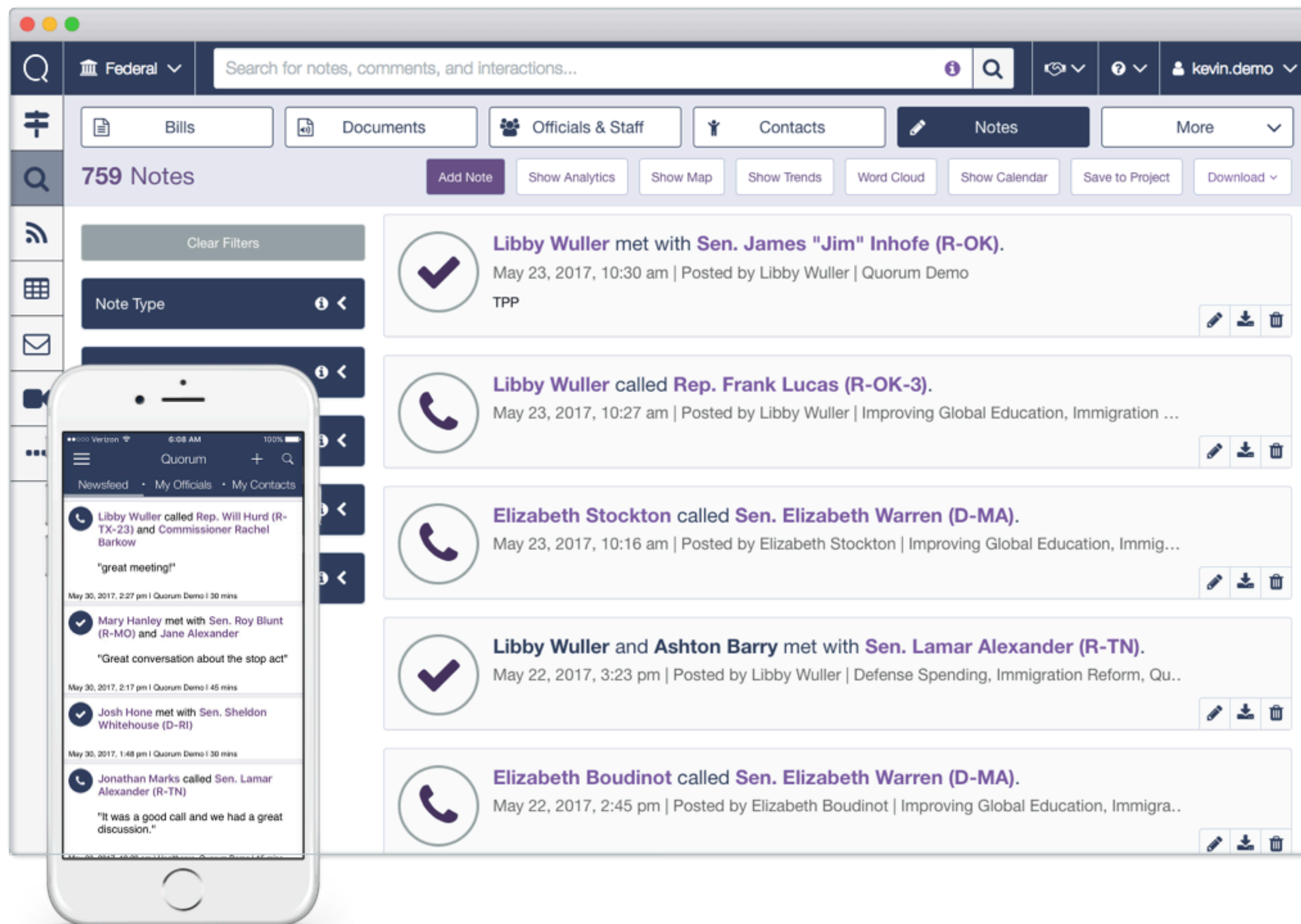
Never Miss A Mention

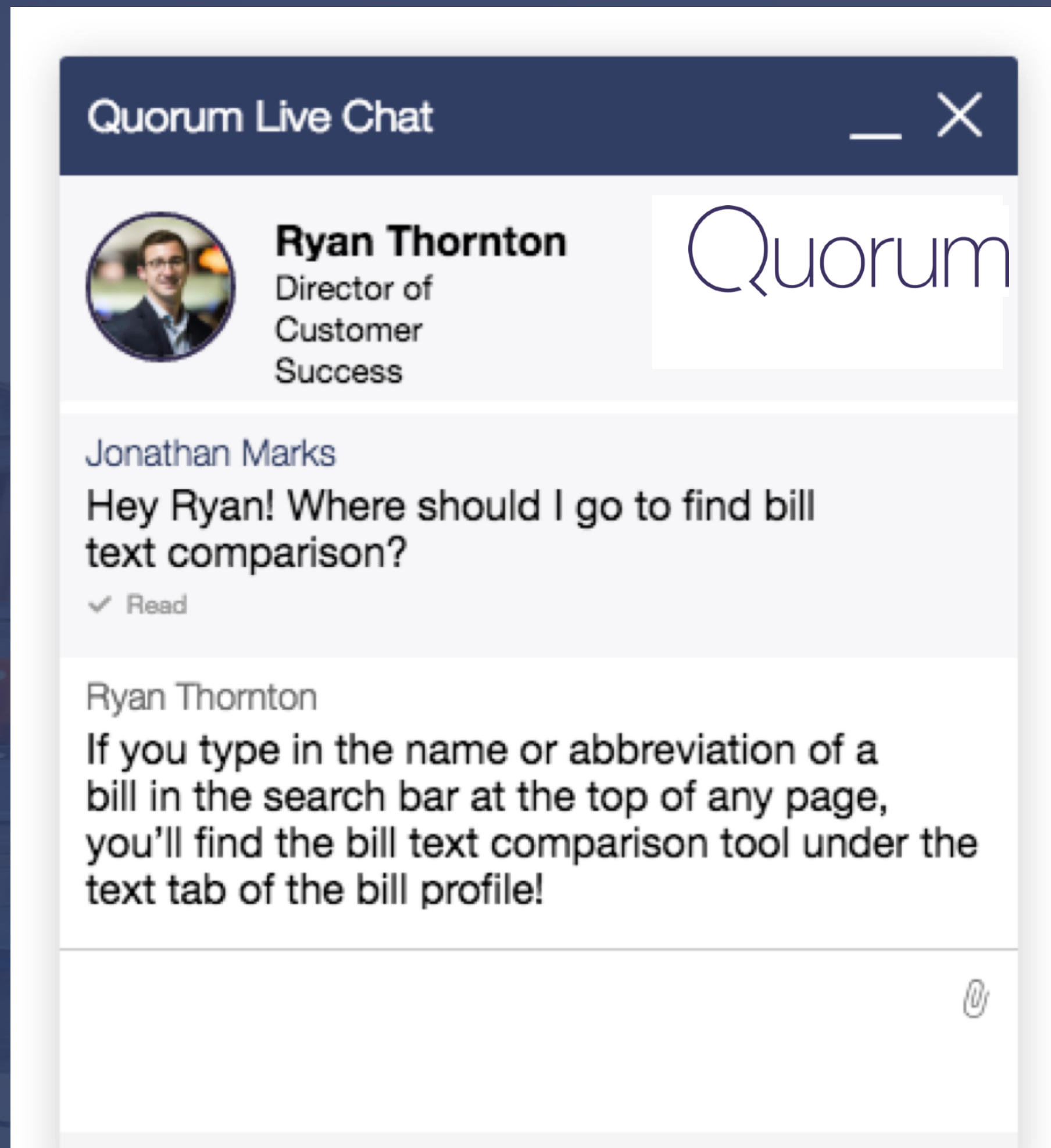
